

Actions to Take after Obtaining Positive Result through using Rapid Antigen Test Kits for COVID-19

Dear Users,

The recent COVID-19 epidemic situation in Hong Kong has been very severe. During this period, the UHS continues to serve many patients every day. In order to protect the health of and to reduce the cross infection risks for all UHS users, if you have done a rapid test with positive result, please **follow the HKSAR Government's guidelines on the actions to take**, and do **NOT** come to the UHS.

If your rapid test result is positive, you should:

1. Stay home, avoid going out, and take personal protective measures.
2. Arrange for further nucleic acid testing:
 - Are you undergoing home quarantine? If so, please contact the "**StayHomeSafe**" **Scheme Hotline [1833 019](tel:1833019)** to report the result immediately.
 - Are you living or working in areas with positive sewage testing results? If so, please call the **dedicated 24-hour hotline [2280 4772](tel:22804772)** to arrange door-to-door sample collection service for confirmatory testing free of charge.
 - Other means of testing (<https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/early-testing.html>)
3. Keep track of your health conditions:
 - Are you feeling unwell? If severe symptoms develop, such as fever at or above 38°C, shortness of breath, palpitations or chest pain, **call 999** as early as possible for ambulance transfer to a hospital.
 - Do you only have mild symptoms? If you only have a mild fever, cough or sore throat, consult a family doctor.
