Trivalent (3 in 1) Seasonal Influenza Vaccination 2026/27

Seasonal influenza vaccination 2026/27 will be available at the University Health Service from 17 September 2026 onwards, while stock lasts.

The available seasonal influenza vaccine is trivalent (3 in 1) and has the following composition:

1. A/Missouri/11/2025 (H1N1) pdm09 - like virus
2. A/Darwin/1454/2025 (H3N2) - like virus
3. B/Tokyo/EIS13-175/2025- like virus

Details:

Date:	From 17 September 2026 onwards, while stock lasts
Time:	9:10 am - 4:30 pm (Mon - Fri)
Target:	All eligible University members aged 6 months or above
Venue:	University Health Service, 2/F Meng Wah Complex, HKU
Cost:	HK\$160 per dose (Cash, Credit card, Alipay, Wechat pay) Free for eligible persons mentioned in the Government's website
Booking in Advance:	Web Booking (From 14 September 2026 at 9:00 am) or in person

Points to note:

1. For vaccine recipients under the age of 18, please be accompanied by Parents/ Guardian for consenting the vaccination.
2. As per requirement of the Government, for eligible persons of Vaccination Subsidy Scheme, please bring along the relevant identity documents to confirm your eligibility. Mandatory eHealth registration is required for Scheme Participants aged 18 years or above.

Remarks:

1. It takes about 2 weeks after vaccination for the body to develop sufficient level of anti-bodies.
2. Please note that you are **NOT allowed to join** the Seasonal Influenza vaccination if:
 - a) you suffer from fever on the day of vaccination
 - b) you have a history of severe allergic reaction to any vaccine component or a previous dose of any influenza vaccine

According to the Recommendations from Centre for Health Protection (CHP), Department of Health (DH), individuals of the following groups are advised to receive Seasonal Influenza Vaccination:

- Healthcare workers
- Persons aged 50 years or above
- Pregnant women (at any gestational age)
- Residents of residential care homes
- Persons with chronic medical problems
- Children and adolescents aged 6 Months to under 18 years
- Poultry workers
- Pig farmers and pig-slaughtering industry personnel
