

Free HIV and Syphilis Rapid Testing on Campus 2026

To: All Eligible Users of University Health Service

Please note that, in response to increasing demand, the Hong Kong AIDS Foundation and University Health Service (UHS) will extend **FREE** HIV and Syphilis rapid testing on HKU campus until August 2026. This program offers a safe and confidential environment for individuals to proactively understand their health and continue the “Test Early. Support Early. Connect Early.” defense line. Testing will be available every Thursday throughout August 2026.

The service is completely **free**, results are confidential, and no embarrassment is involved: you can make an online appointment for testing. Everyone who has ever had sex is encouraged to test for HIV and Syphilis on a regular basis, so that infections can be detected and treated early, effectively reducing transmission risk and associated complications.
