## About the HPV Vaccination Catch-up Programme

DH has launched a one-off Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Catch-up Programme (the Programme) to provide catch-up HPV vaccination for female Hong Kong residents who were born between 2004 and 2008 and are not covered by the existing Government HPV vaccination programme. Eligible persons can receive two doses of vaccination free-of-charge under the Programme. The Programme has been implemented in three phases and will last until end of 2026.

For your reference, cervical cancer is one of the top ten most common and deadly cancers among women in Hong Kong. Almost all cervical cancers are caused by persistent infection with high-risk types of HPV. The HPV vaccine is very effective in preventing the high-risk HPV types that most commonly cause cervical cancer. To protect you from cervical cancer as well as other HPV-related cancers or diseases, you are encouraged to receive HPV vaccination early under the Programme.
