- currently studying in University (HKU); and
- registered with eHealth

The HPV vaccine for the Programme will be available at University Health Service from 9th July 2025 onwards, while stock lasts.

Points to note:

- For all vaccine recipients, please bring along all your past vaccination record for checking and recording.

- For vaccine recipients aged 18 or above, please bring along your HKIC as giving electronic consent to the vaccination.

- For vaccine recipients **under the age of 18**, please **bring along the completed** <u>HPV Vaccination Consent Form</u> (with Parents/ Guardian signature) during the day of vaccination, as per requirement of DH. A **consent form is required for each dose of vaccination**.
