

[Update] Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Catch-up Programme

To: HKU Students,

In response to WHO's recommendation, the Department of Health (DH) has launched the one-off Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination Catch-up Programme, with an aim to gradually boost the herd immunity of the community against high-risk HPV infection to prevent cervical cancer as well as other HPV-related cancers or diseases. The target vaccine recipients included:

- female Hong Kong residents; and
- born between 2004 and 2008; and
- not yet completed HPV vaccination; and
- registered with eHealth

Eligible female Hong Kong residents can make their appointment at Women Wellness Satellites (WWSs) / WWS Service Points or designated District Health Centres (DHC) / DHC Express under the Primary Healthcare Commission (PHCC) of Health Bureau to receive free HPV vaccination.
